### 1981-1982

In the fall of 1981, Stuart Resor made initial contact with developer Arnold "Bud" Fischer, who owned the 1883 Schoolhouse, then on 4<sup>th</sup> and H. (The Schoolhouse was moved by George Roberts, who bought it in 1927 after it was shuttered when the new Central School [now Paul Ecke Elementary] opened.) Fischer was developing the condos on the bluff by 4<sup>th</sup> and H; After much back-and-forth, on 1 Oct 1982 Fischer sold the Schoolhouse for \$1 to the Leucadia/Encinitas Town Council and the Leucadia/Encinitas Historical Society, which in Feb 1982 had 62 members.

Note: Also near 4<sup>th</sup> and H was the Aldrich Castle, which could not be rescued and was torn down in 1983-84.

North County Times (20 January 1983), "Historical Meeting Scheduled: the Congress of History will hold a special joint meeting with the Leucadia, Encinitas Historical Society at noon Sat in the Olivenhain Meeting Hall...Phone John Farleigh."

On Friday the 13<sup>th</sup> of May, 1983, the Schoolhouse was moved 2 blocks north to a site just west of Pacific View Elementary School, about 100 feet from where it had been originally built in 1883. This land was owned by Encinitas Unified School District, which by July 1982 had agreed to the move.

That same day, Friday the 13<sup>th</sup>, pursuant to the proclamation of Pres. Ronald Reagan, the US observed "American Indian Day." Proclamation 5049, dated April 14, 1983, followed up on President Richard Nixon's 1970 policy of self-determination and commitment to federal support of self-governance of tribal nations. Reagan proclaimed, "Throughout our history, the government-to-government relationship between the United States and Indian tribes has endured. The Constitution, treaties, laws, and court decisions have consistently recognized a unique political relationship between Indian tribes and the United States." the Aktá Lakota Museum's Post, has this entry for 13 May 2025: "Although a great statement, his policies towards the Tohono O'odham, White Earth Reservation, Mashantucket Pequot, Cherokee Nation of Oklahoma, and the Eastern Band of Cherokee, Navajo, Yakama, and many other tribal nations were a contradiction to Proclamation 5049."
